**John 11:45-57**

<sup>45</sup> Many of the Jews therefore, who had come with Mary and had seen what Jesus did, believed in him. <sup>46</sup>But some of them went to the Pharisees and told them what he had done. <sup>47</sup>So the chief priests and the Pharisees called a meeting of the council, and said, 'What are we to do? This man is performing many signs. <sup>48</sup>If we let him go on like this,

everyone will believe in him, and the Romans will come and destroy both our holy place and our nation.’<sup>49</sup> But one of them, Caiaphas, who was high priest that year, said to them, ‘You know nothing at all! <sup>50</sup>You do not understand that it is better for you to have one man die for the people than to have the whole nation destroyed.’<sup>51</sup> He did not say this on his own, but being high priest that year he prophesied that Jesus was about to die for the nation,<sup>52</sup> and not for the nation only, but to gather into one the dispersed children of God.<sup>53</sup> So from that day on they planned to put him to death.

<sup>54</sup> Jesus therefore no longer walked about openly among the Jews, but went from there to a town called Ephraim in the region near the wilderness; and he remained there with the disciples.

<sup>55</sup> Now the Passover of the Jews was near, and many went up from the country to Jerusalem before the Passover to purify themselves.<sup>56</sup> They were looking for Jesus and were asking one another as they stood in the temple, ‘What do you think? Surely he will not come to the festival, will he?’<sup>57</sup> Now the chief priests and the Pharisees had given orders that anyone who knew where Jesus was should let them know, so that they might arrest him.
